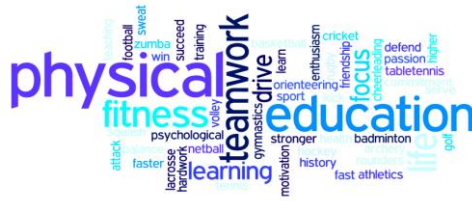

## Survival Swim Day

On Thursday the 30<sup>th</sup> of August all students will be doing a survival swim at the pool. This requires your child to swim in clothing whilst being asked to do a range of movements in the water. This is a very important day for all students. Your child will need to bring the following clothing to swim in:

- Shorts
- T-shirt
- Long Trousers
- Long sleeve shirt
- Bathers

The clothing should not be swimming shorts or woollen items. We would like to create a scenario that is as close to real life as possible. Old pieces of clothing would be best, pyjamas work well too. Students will not be swimming in their clothes for the whole lesson.

We are participating in the memory of Mrs. King's mum Kerry who lost her battle with MS in February this year.

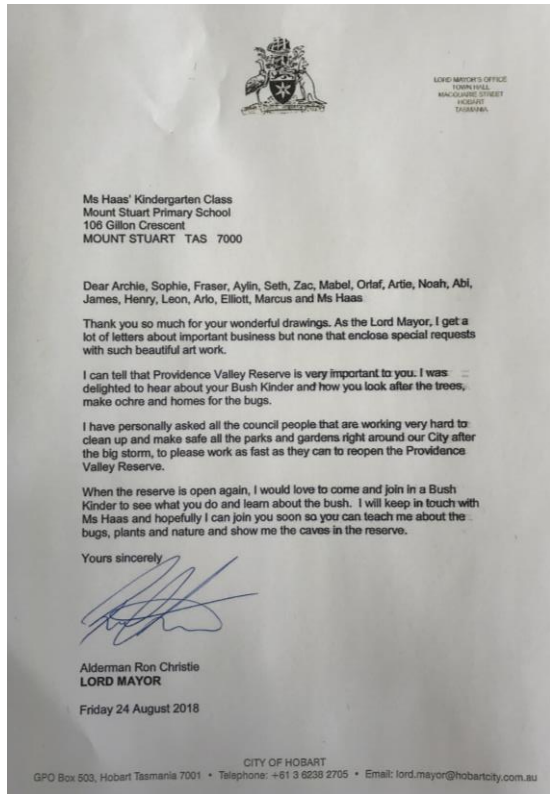
